KID TALK QUESTIONS

KID TALK: After Reading + Box

Take the Fidget Snake out of the box.

- **I wonder... what CHOICES could I make that would change this shape?**
- **What other shapes can you imagine making with the same object?**
(Try to make 1 or 2 of them for the kids.)
- **TO CLOSE: Wow—you could SEE another way! God gives us EYES TO SEE and CHOICES TO MAKE to change enemies into FRIENDS... and help make God’s dream for our world come true!**

KID PAGE: Love Your Enemies

KID CHALLENGE: Clay Transformations

- Kids are at tables with their clay.
- Discuss ideas of something harsh to make that could be transformed, such as:

Thorns → a **flower**

A sword → the **cross** of Jesus

A snake → the shape of a **heart**

The face of an enemy → the face of a **friend**

Friends, Teammates & First-Time Listeners



Sit in the center carpet with a box of Social Manners Cards and invite kids to come join the circle.

- **SHOW & TELL:** Show kids an illustrated scenario and discuss what seems to be happening.
- **ASK: “In this picture, do you see someone being a GOOD FRIEND, a GOOD TEAMMATE, or a FIRST-TIME LISTENER?”**
- Discuss what choices the characters could make to change the story.
